



Golf Course Rules and Etiquette

The golf course rules and etiquette are as follows:

- Tee times will have 10 minutes interval.
- Boavista Golf reserves the right to group four players per tee time.
- Maximum EGA Handicaps permitted: Ladies 34; Men 26.
- All players must wear appropriate golf shoes on the course with soft spikes. Metal spikes are not allowed on the golf course.
- Dress code must be observed for the golf course and clubhouse as stipulated on the Course Regulations, no beachwear, no denims, no training shoes, no t-shirts, socks must be worn.
- All players are responsible for any damage caused to any hired equipment during their round.
- Each player must have his/her own golf bag with their own set of clubs.
- A buggy may carry a maximum of two (2) players and two (2) golf bags and no person under the age of 18 may drive a buggy hired at Boavista Golf Course.

Bad weather policy

These are the conditions for the various situations that arise due to bad weather:

THE COURSE MAY BE CLOSED FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- Flooded greens;
- Thunder, lightning or inclement weather *;
- If the conditions are bad enough in any way as to be considered dangerous to the players or damaging to the golf course.

* In inclement weather, a final decision will be made by the Golf Director or Course Superintendent. All players due to play golf on a day when the course is closed should firstly be offered alternative day of play. Any guests who are unable to accept an alternative day will be issued a rain check voucher.

THE COURSE IS CLOSED AFTER THE GUEST HAS STARTED HIS/HER ROUND

- If the course is closed after the guest has played less than 5 holes, a rain check voucher for 18 holes will be given.
- If the client has played 5 or more holes a rain check voucher for 9 holes will be given.
